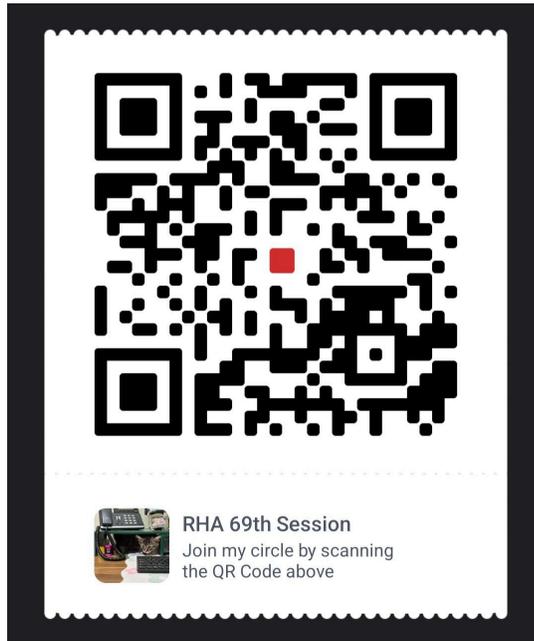

- (b) **Point of Information:** Used to ask for clarification regarding the content of a motion or the process, enabling better-informed voting.
- (c) **Point of Personal Privilege:** Addresses urgent issues affecting the comfort, safety, or dignity of a member or the assembly (e.g., noise, temperature, inability to hear).
- (d) **Point of Parliamentary Inquiry:** A question directed to the chair to ask about the current parliamentary rules or the effect of a motion

(1) VPNR | How might you work to avoid burnout and over-committing within RHA?

(a) This is why we have committees and it would be beneficial to split duties among representatives . We also need to delegate and work on our prioritization.

(2) Markley 2 | How might you combat apathy within RHA?

(a) I would hope that none of us are apathetic and that we are here for a reason, but that is a fair point. What I would say is, try to explain to people the reason why they should care. Communication and conversation is a strong tool to encourage caring about stuff.

(3) MoJo 1 | Could you talk about your past experience in RHA?

(a) I was Markley treasurer during freshman year. We had a good year and won Program of Year and Building Block awards. We had 100+ people at our stuff-a-plush event. We helped to spearhead the hill dormal which was a learning experience where we worked with Couzens, Stockwell, and Oxford. I worked over the summer for RHA as a returner rep where I had the chance to help interview a new member of upper housing. It was a great oppoutinuty to advocate for the future of residential life. This year, I have been less involved than I would want to be, but I think running for eboard would help me to be more involved.

(4) EVP | How would you balance the work that comes with being on Eboard?

- (a) I think that planning what needs to happen and when is very important. A lot of my tasks are cyclical, but RHA is a year-long commitment that is very important. RHA, I feel, is a priority due to the impact that it has on many students. Working on prioritizing would be very important.

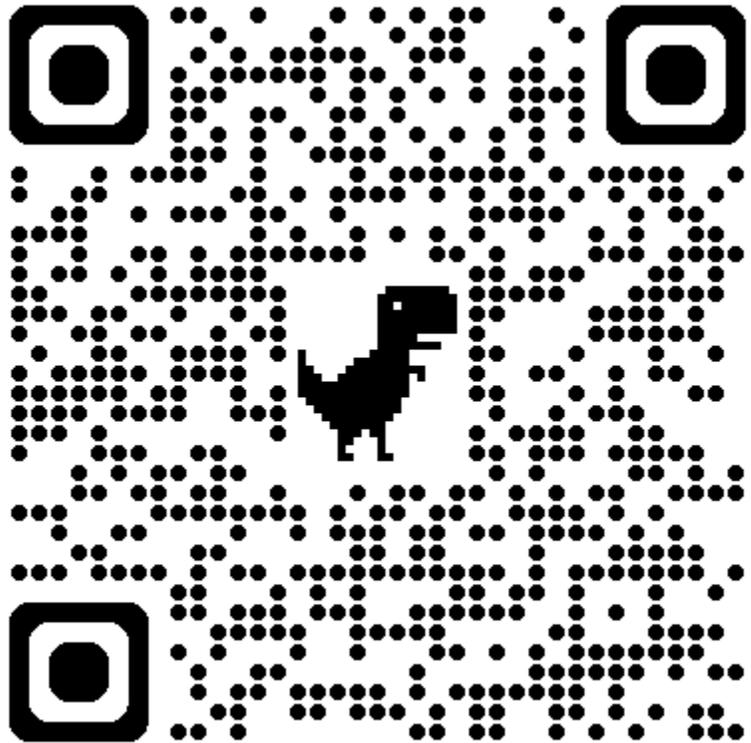

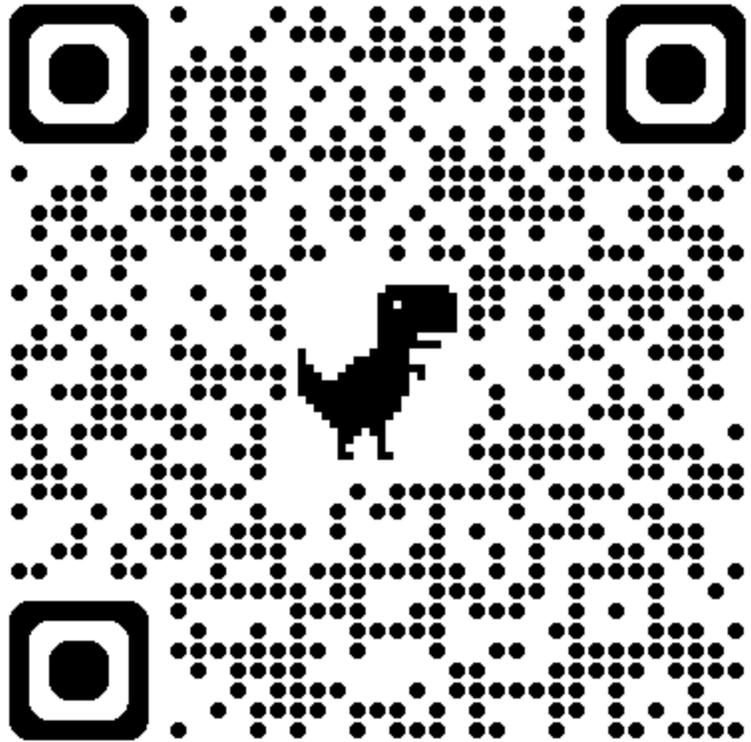

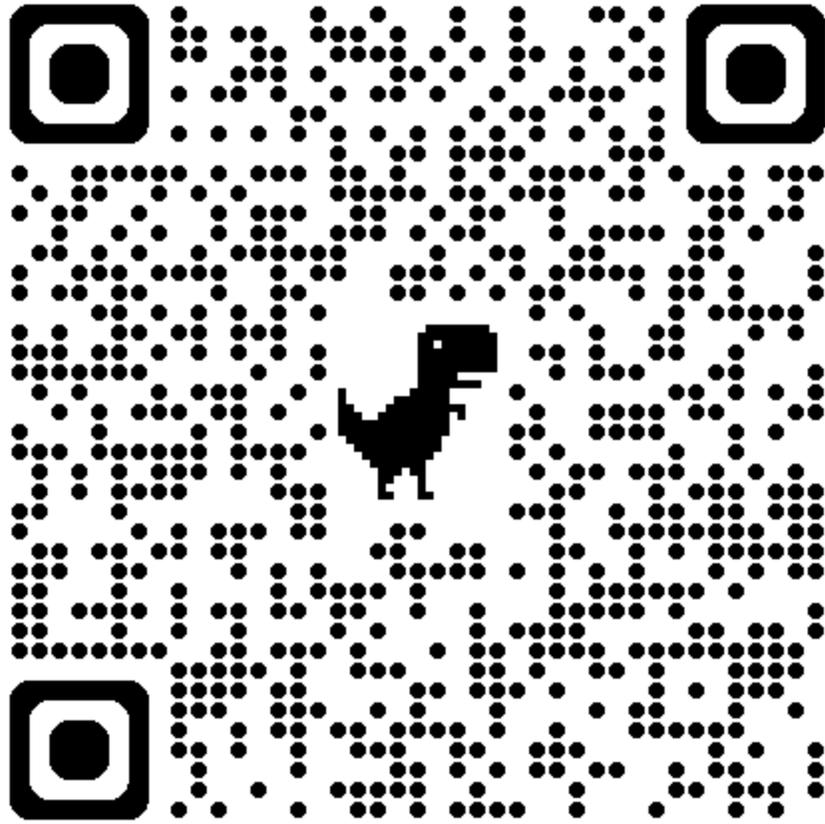
