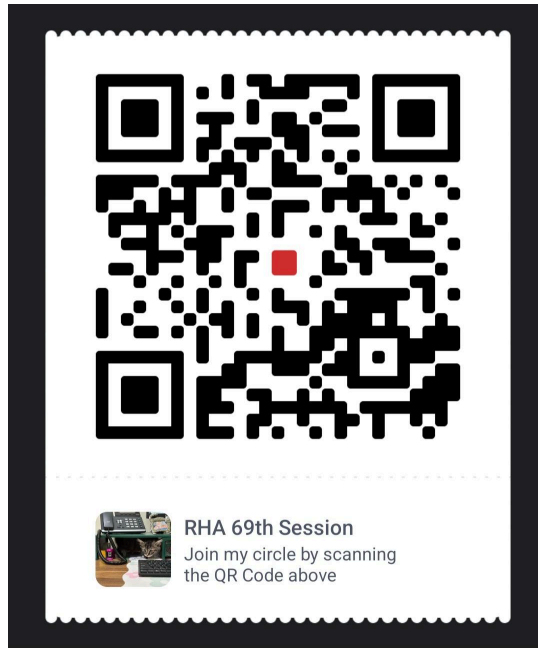

4. Updates on NACURH + How to Get Involved - 69th & 70th Eboard unanimously vote to not attend NACURH 72 @ Texas A&M University
 - a)  Press Release 69th: NACURH 60th Texas A&M
 - (1) Requiring housing registration as “Sex at Birth” for both advisors and delegates. Requires conforming to male or female.
 - (2) Educational Sessions - cannot mention ‘identity’ in the presentation, despite a prompt being “ways to help on-campus residents feel at home.” - we’ve had an ed session submission denied due to mentioning identity (non-traditional student).
 - (a) **“Texas A&M System Compliance Reminder: *As a presenter at a Texas public institution, you must ensure your session complies with Senate Bill 17 and Texas A&M System Policy 08.01, which restricts university-sponsored activities related to diversity, equity, and inclusion (DEI). While student organizations are generally exempt, presentations must not be funded or promoted by the university in ways that violate SB 17 or Texas A&M System Policy 08.01. Please review your content and consult your institution’s compliance office/ your advisor if you have questions.*”**
 - b) We unanimously agreed that the conference would not be safe for our delegates to attend, and it would not be morally acceptable to spend resident money on initiatives that do not support their diverse identities.
 - c) We are looking to submit a press release to NACURH, if you feel strongly or want to offer your input, please add your testimony to this document.

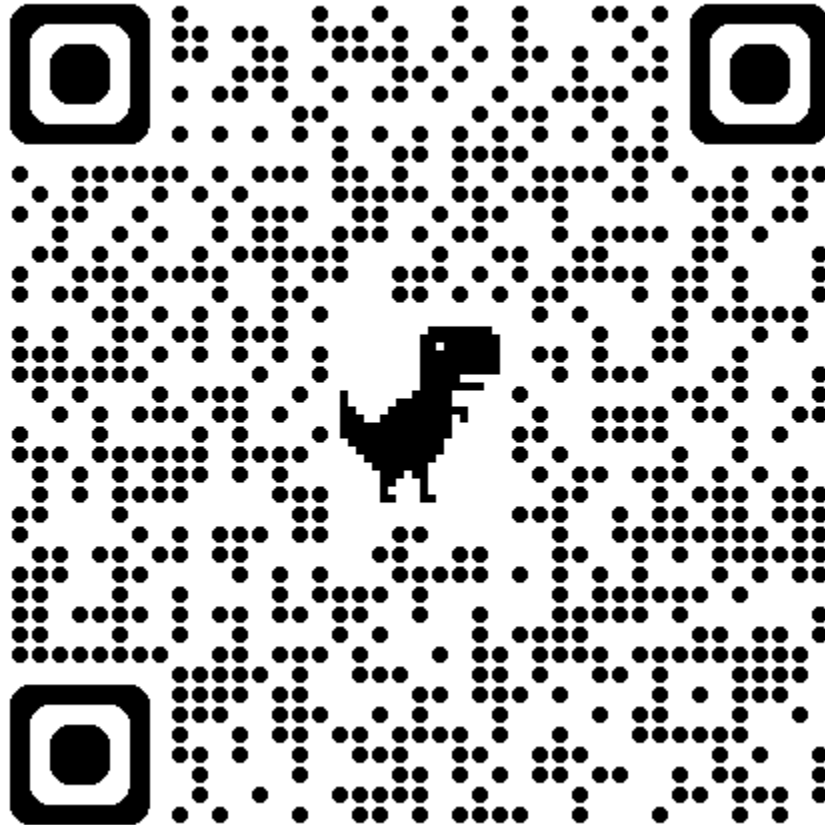
